Brief Curriculum Vitae

Dr. Haralampos Milionis was born in 1968 in Ioannina, Greece. He is currently a Professor of Internal Medicine at the School of Health Sciences, Department of Medicine, University of Ioannina, Greece. He graduated from the Medical School of the University of Ioannina, Greece in 1991 with "Excellent" and received his PhD in 1999 (http://thesis.ekt.gr/thesisBookReader/id/11329).

His research activity and training were further enhanced during sabbaticals at the Department of Molecular Biology and Clinical Biochemistry at the Royal Free Hospital, UCL, London, UK, in 1999, and at the Stroke Unit of the Centre Hospitalier Universitaire Vaudois (CHUV), Lausanne, Switzerland, in 2011.

He currently serves as the Academic Head and Director of the First Department of Internal Medicine at the Regional University General Hospital of Ioannina, Greece, as well as the Immunology Research Laboratory of the First Department of Internal Medicine at the University of Ioannina Medical School. Since January 2020, he has also been the Coordinator of the Infectious Diseases Unit.

He works as a consultant in the Outpatient Clinic of Cardiometabolic Diseases and the Outpatient Lipid Clinic of the University General Hospital of Ioannina, Greece and leads the Outpatient Lipid Clinic for Children and Adolescents at the University Hospital of Ioannina, Greece.

He is a member of the Atherothrombosis Research Center at the University of Ioannina, Greece.

He is an active member of the Hellenic Atherosclerosis Society (HAS) and the European Atherosclerosis Society (EAS) and a Fellow of the Hellenic Stroke Organization (HSO) and the European Stroke Organization (ESO). He serves as President of the Board of Directors of the Hellenic Atherosclerosis Society and is a Board Member of the Hellenic Stroke Organization.

His research interests focus on:

- the pathophysiology of atherothrombosis and metabolic disorders (specifically concerning lipoproteins, diabetes, and obesity),
- the clinical and epidemiological study of risk factors for cardiovascular disease, and
- the secondary prevention of stroke and its prognosis.

He has participated and continues to participate in a significant number of observational clinical studies and randomized clinical trials. He has authored and co-authored more than 400 publications in peer-reviewed international journals (*h-index 53, citations > 10,000*) and serves as a reviewer and member of the editorial board of both Greek and international journals.
